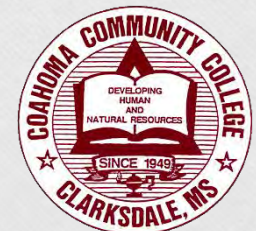

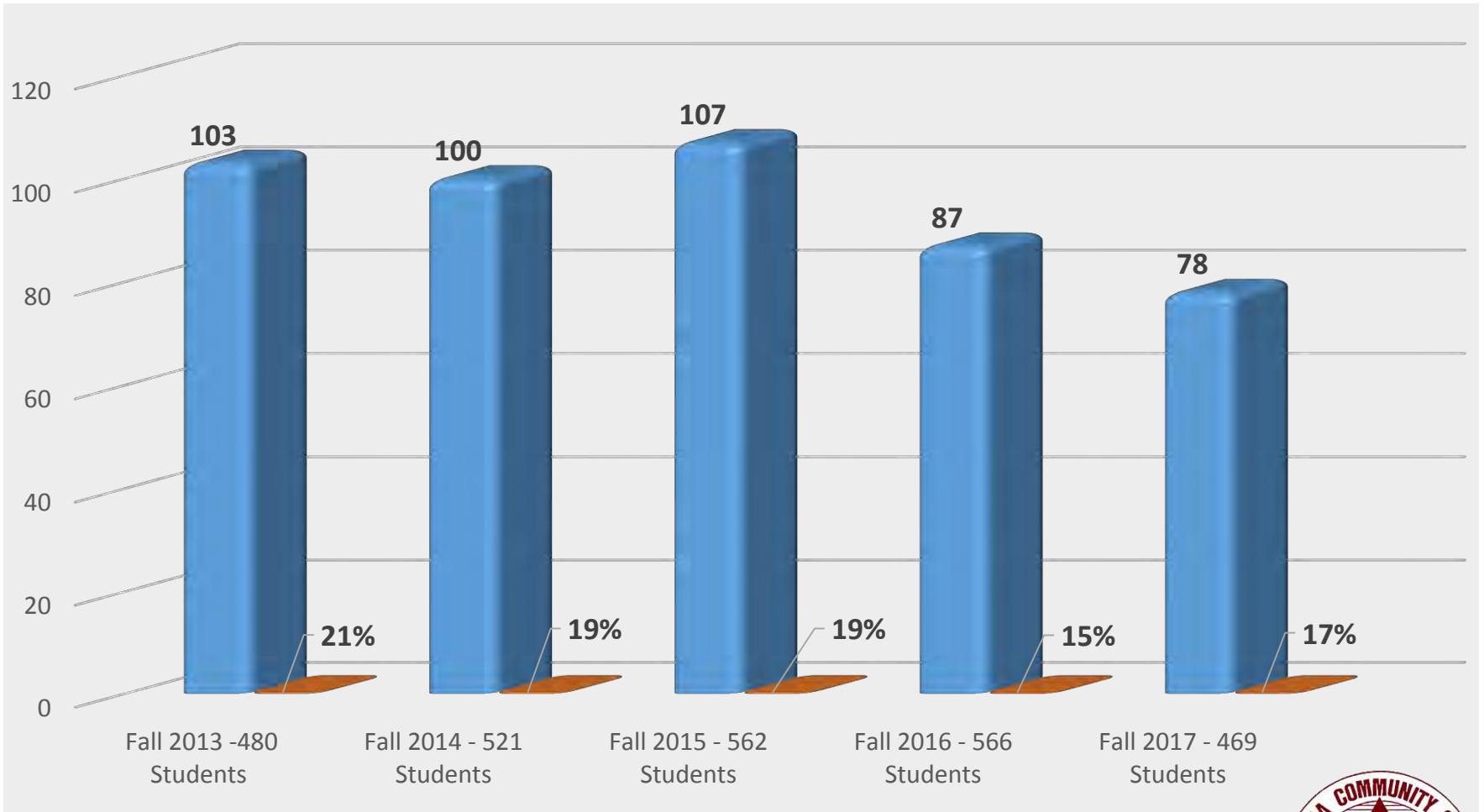

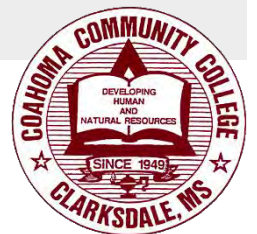
# **2018 ATD Cohort Kickoff Data**



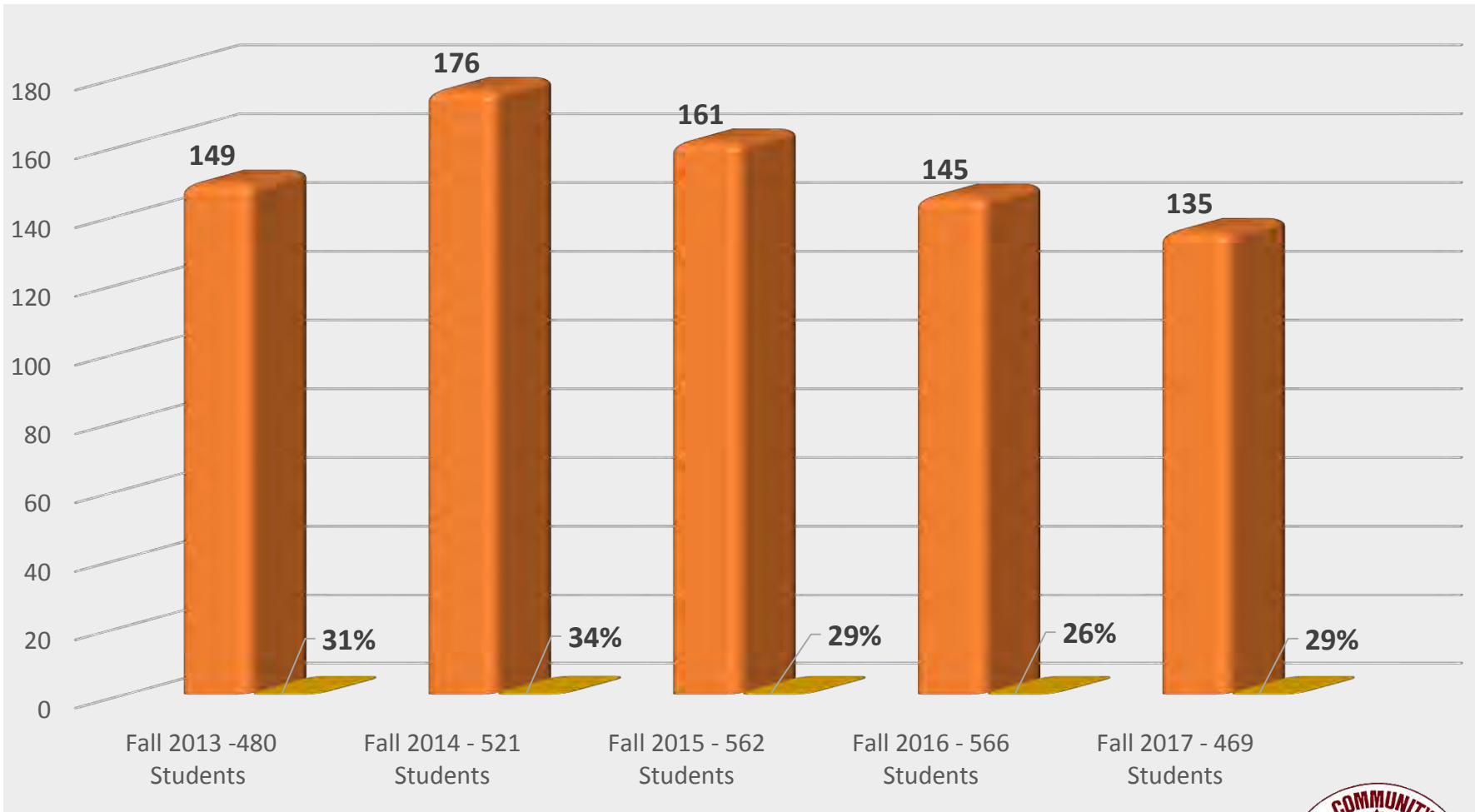
# Total FTEIC Students Completed College Math in year 1



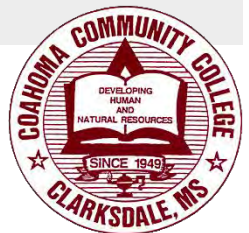

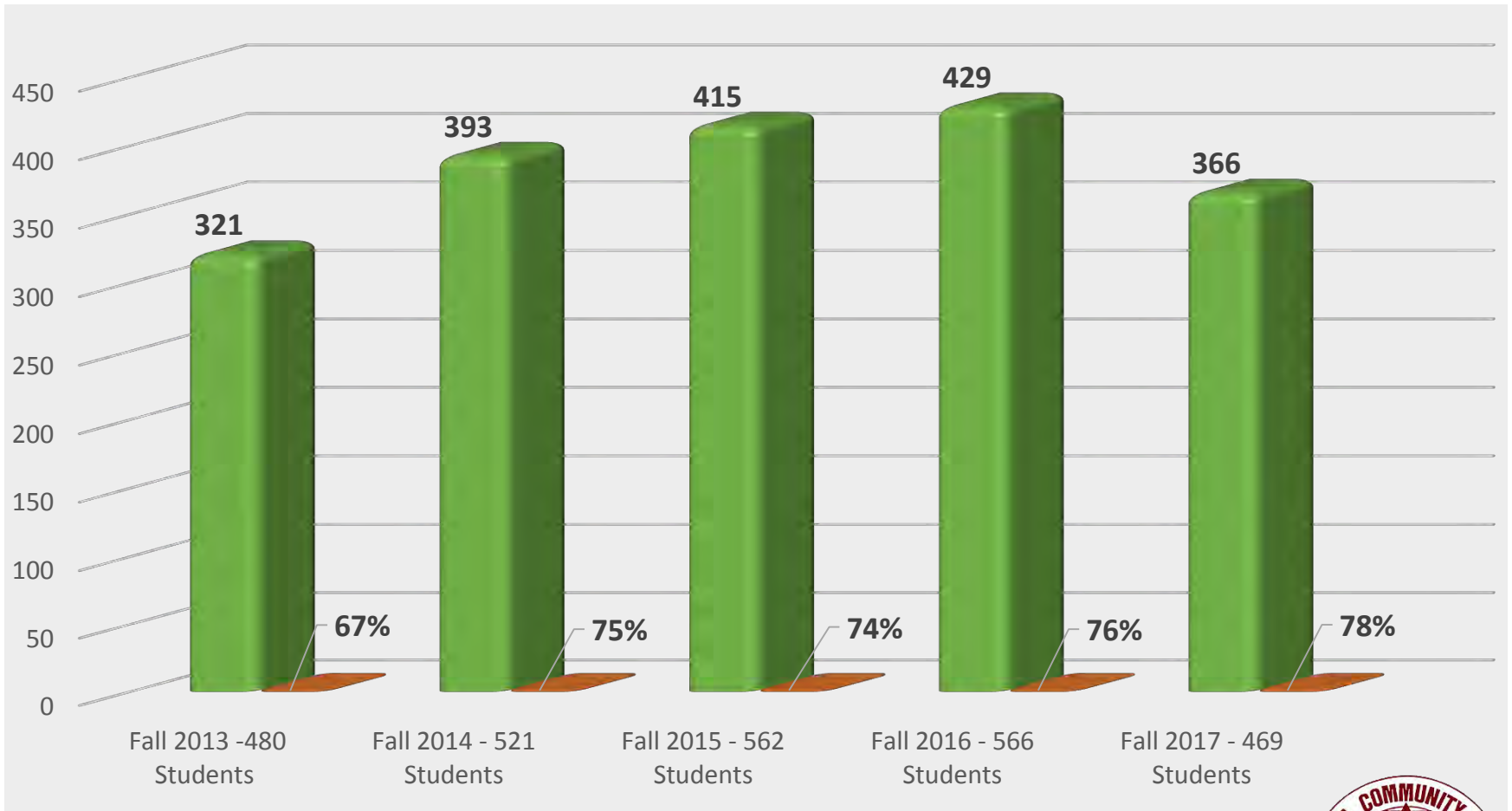
# Total FTEIC Students Completed College English in year 1



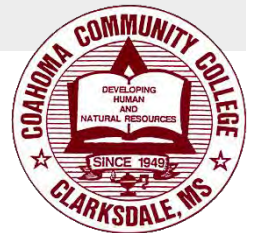

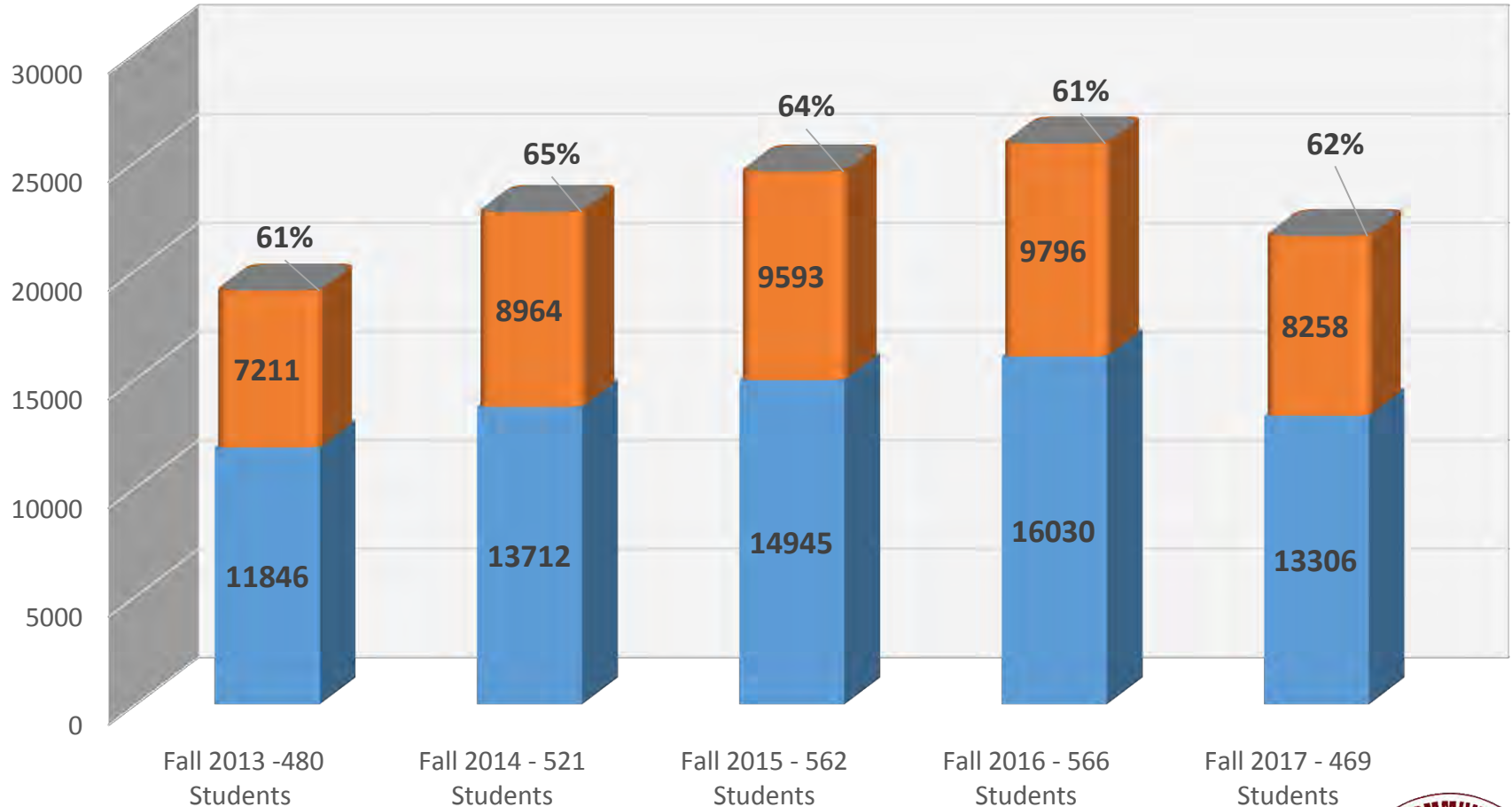
## Total FTEIC Students Persisted from Term 1 to term 2



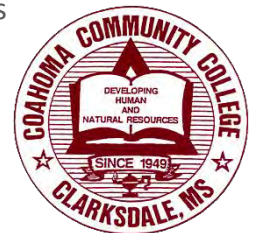

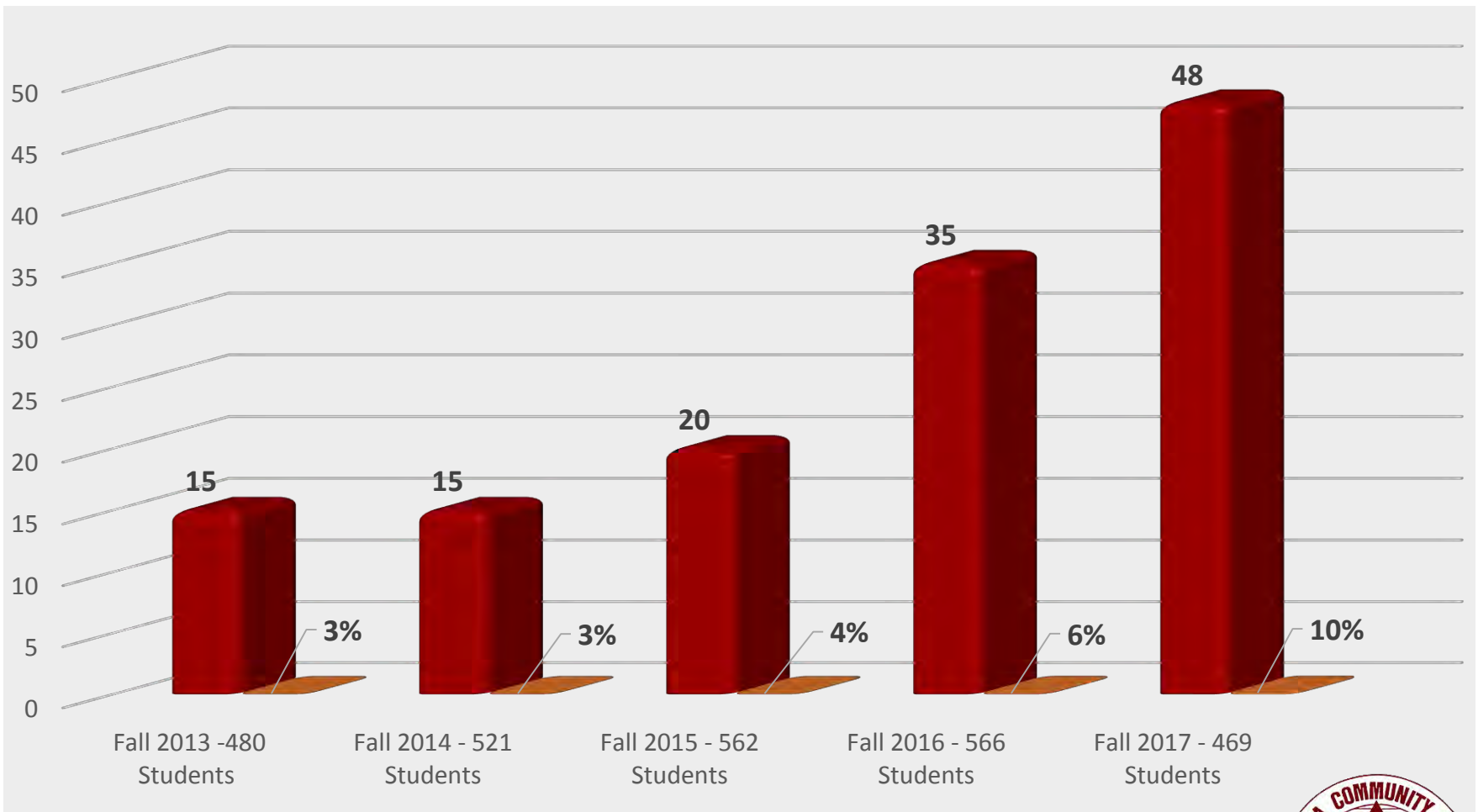
## Total FTEIC Students Total College Credits Attempted / Completed



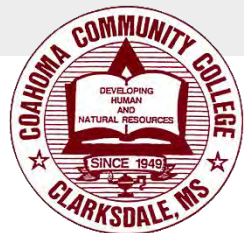
■ Total Credits Attempted

# Total FTEIC Students College Ready

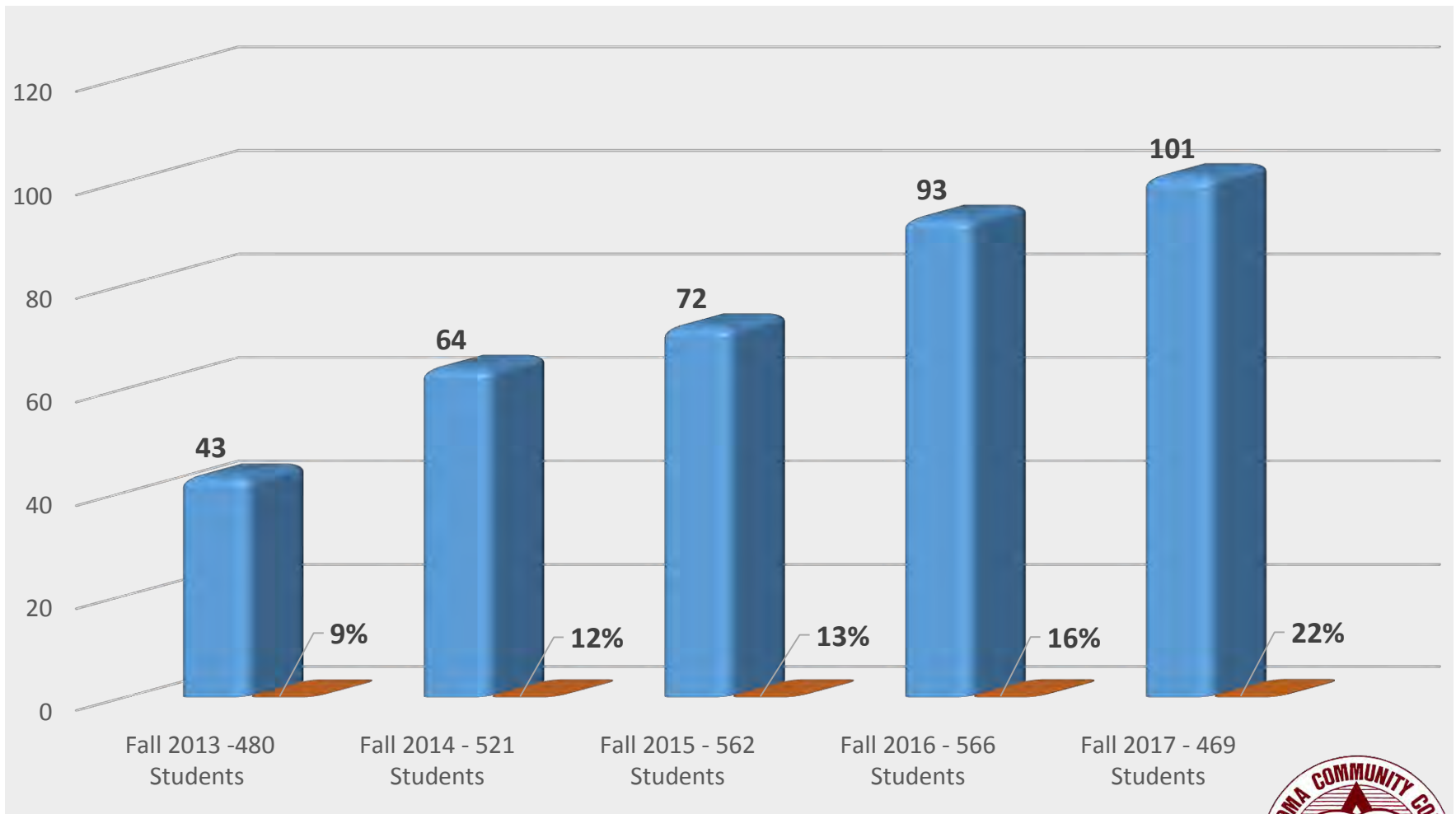

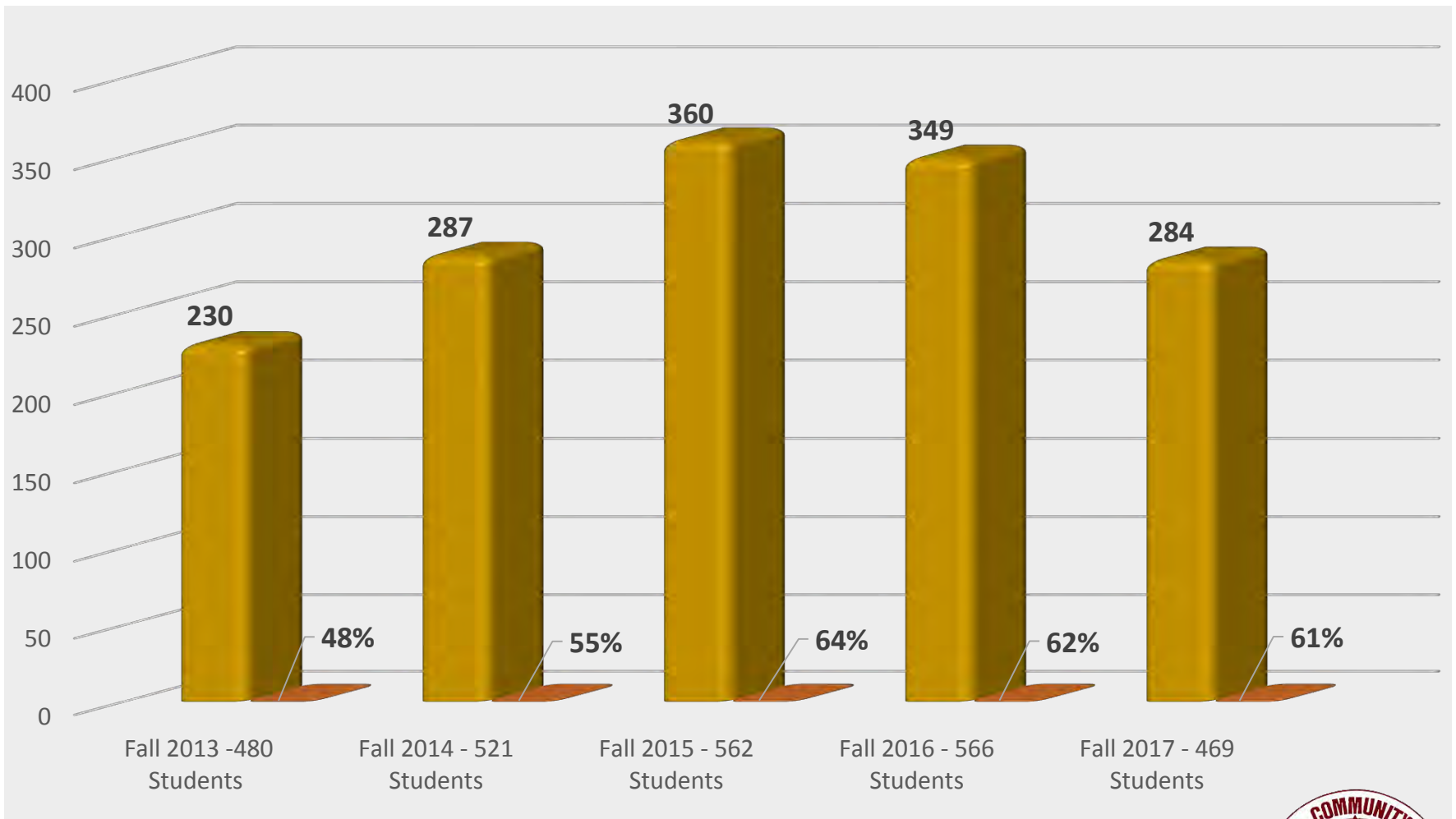
# Total FTEIC Students Referred to Dev Ed in 1 Subject



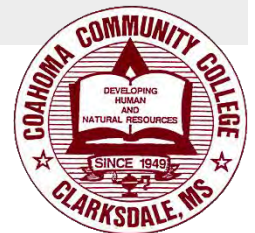

## Total FTEIC Students Referred to Dev Ed in 2 Subjects

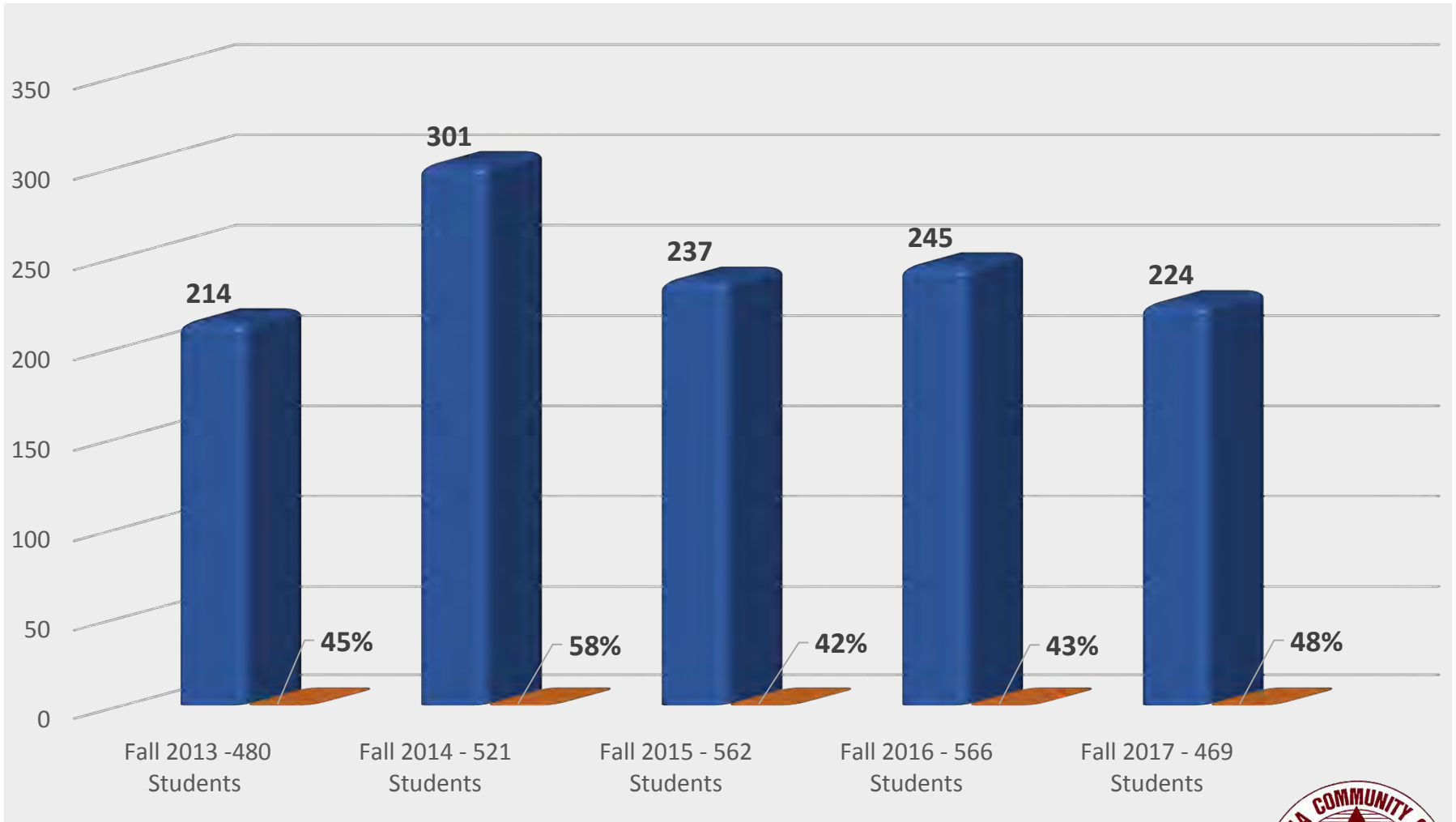

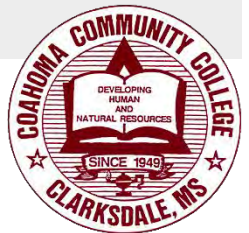




# Total FTEIC Students Traditional College Age



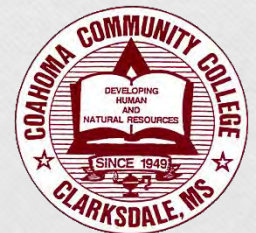

student tuition & fees were 36% of our budget.

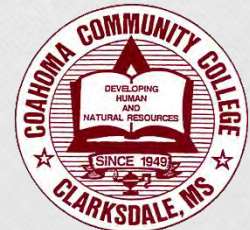




# DUAL ENROLLMENT

Note: DE (Dual Enrollment)  
**Spring 2016–Fall 2016**

- ✓ 22% of DE students remain at their High School
- ✓ 22% of DE students enroll at CCC
- ✓ 9% of DE students graduate from High School and go to another Community College
- ✓ 19% of DE students graduate from High School and go to a four year college
- ✓ 27% of DE students simply do not return to CCC or go to another college



# DUAL ENROLLMENT

Note: DE (Dual Enrollment)

- ✓ In 2013/14 CCC served 837 DE students
- ✓ In 2014/15 CCC served 1,452 DE students
- ✓ In 2015/16 CCC served 1,757 DE students
- ✓ In 2016/17 CCC served 2,202 DE students

At **\$100** for each **3** hour course we made **\$73,400**  
Average cost is **\$450** for each **3** hour course for **\$330,300**

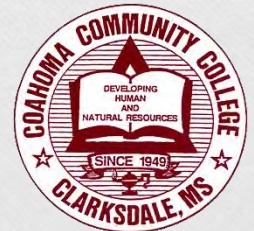

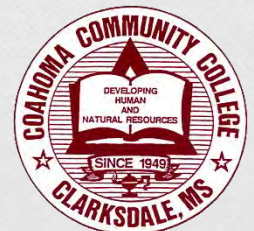

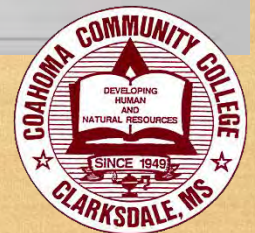

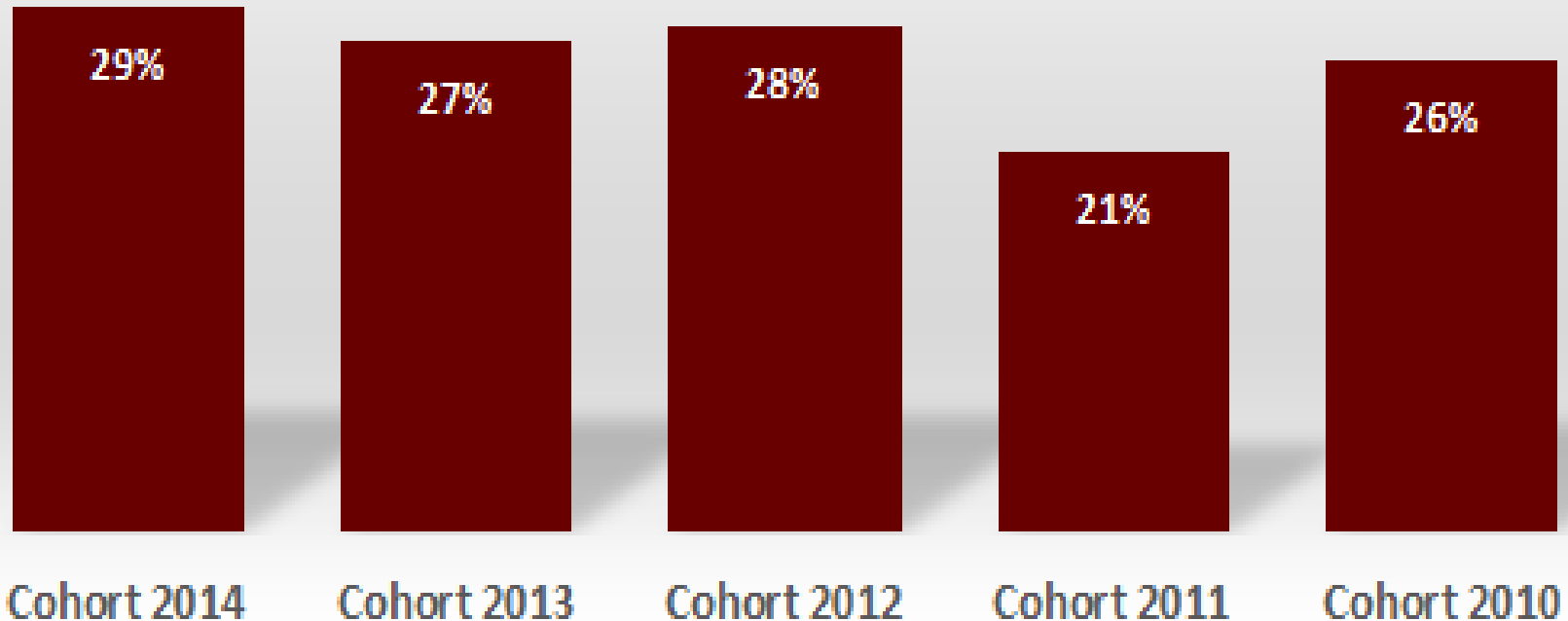
## CCC SUMMER I & II ENROLLMENT - Y2013-Y2018

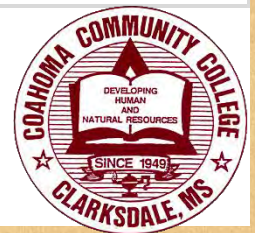


# 5-YEAR GRADUATION RATES AT 150% OR THREE YEARS OF NORMAL TIME



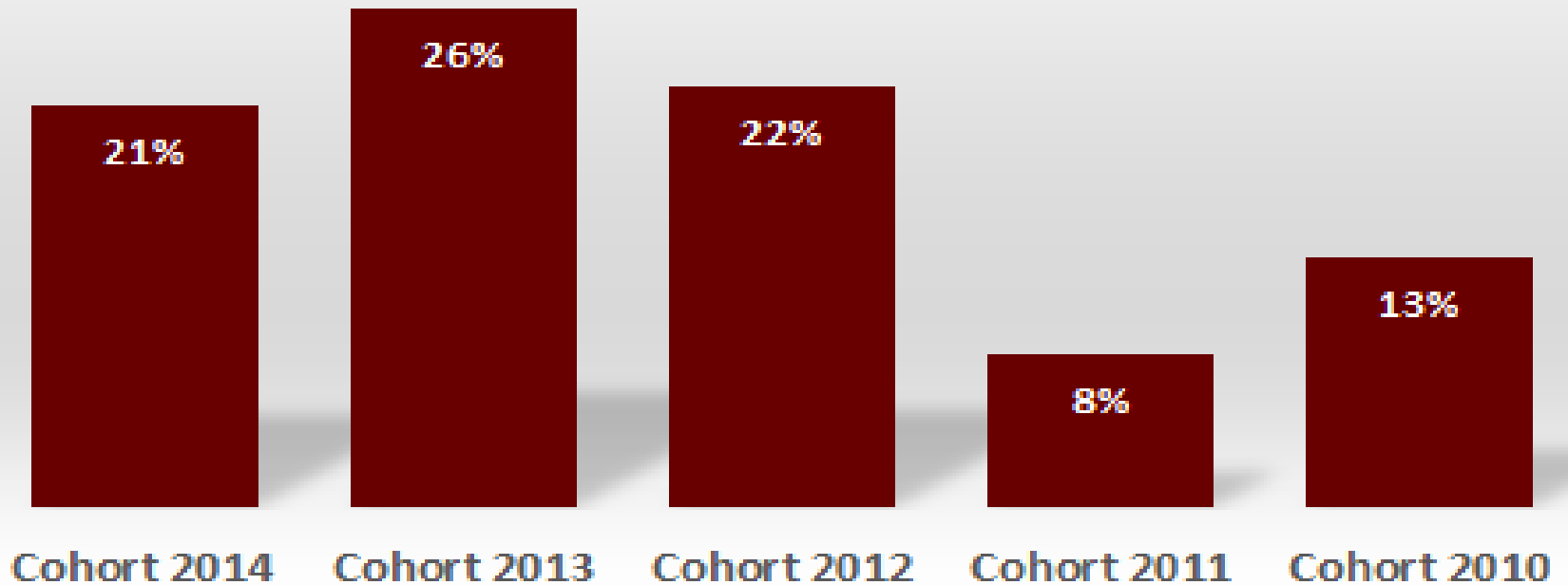

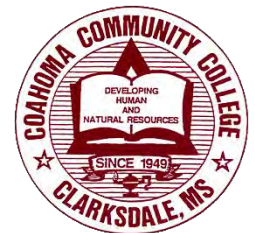


# 5-YEAR TRANSFER RATES AT 150% OR THREE YEARS OF NORMAL TIME

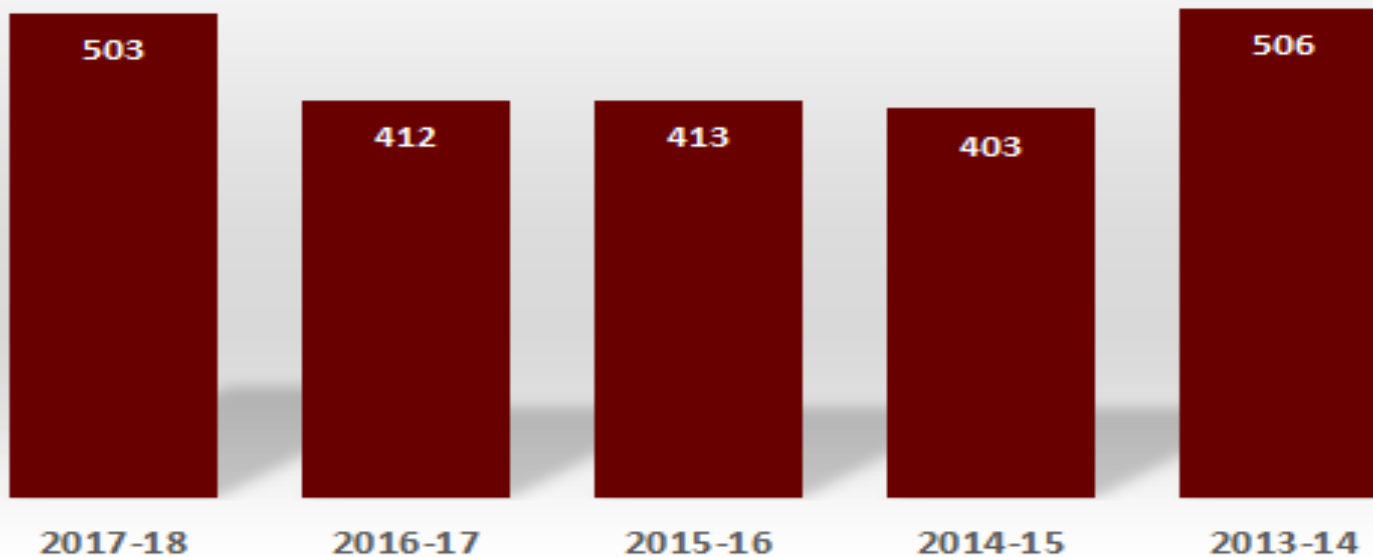
