ORIENTATION COURSE

GOAL 2:

First time ever in college (FTEIC) students will become actively engaged in their education by **completing a revitalized orientation** course within the first 21 hours

OUTCOME 1.

41% will be enrolled and complete the orientation class with 70% pass rate or higher

OUTCOME 2:

Increase the number of FTEIC students completing orientation with their first 21 hours to 3% in each of 5-year plan starting from 36% Benchmark for 2018-2019
