SPRING 2022 COMPARED TO SPRING 2021 ENROLLMENT

This enrollment data reflects the 10th Day Preliminary Enrollment for Spring 2022, with a total enrollment of 1,578. Compared to Spring 2021 preliminary enrollment, enrollment has increased by a total of 300 students or by 24%. The final enrollment as January 26, 2022, (excluding Drops/Withdrawals) is 1607. The enrollment data was obtained from the IT Department (iZenda Reports). OVERVIEW OF DATA

ENROLLMENT: Coahoma Community College has worked tirelessly with recruitment, retention and advisors to reach a 24% increase in enrollment for Spring 2022. This percent of increase was compared to Spring 2021 of 1279. PERSISTENCE: The College had a total of 1,067 to persist from Fall 2021 to Spring 2022. The persistence rate is 67.62%. LEARNING FORMAT: The pandemic has truly had an impact on the students' choice to take face-to-face classes and online classes. For the first time in the history of the college a total of 49.18% who are taking classes in the virtual format ONLY. The College has made great efforts in providing the students all the necessary resources they need to be successful in a online format. LOCATION: The largest percent of our currently enroll students for this term resides in Coahoma County and in the the state of Mississippi at a rate of 34.09% and 95.18%. GENDER: Females make up 61.47% of the student population. The College recognizes that efforts to increase male enrollment is a priority as well as older adult learners. STATUS: The institution has been successful in enrolling the majority of the students in full-time status with a total of 959 students or 60.77% for the total credit hours of 16,002. Our enrollment in diversity for white students decreased by 33% compared to Spring 2021.
