

Coahoma Community College Library Orientation Survey Report 2012-2013

During fall 2012 and spring 2013, Coahoma Community College's library staff provided library orientation to students enrolled at the institution. Instructors and students evaluated the library orientation with the Library Orientation Survey.

While 10 instructors and 2,026 students participated in the survey in the fall, 15 instructors and 2,014 students participated in the survey in the spring. Respondents included faculty and students from the main campus and the institution's off-campus sites. This report provides the faculty survey results as well as student survey results.

Fall 2012 Orientation Survey Report


During Fall 2012, Coahoma Community College's library staff conducted library orientation to a total of 15 classes on the main campus and at the institution's off-campus sites. A total of 2,026 students and 10 instructors evaluated the orientation with the Library Orientation Survey.

The survey asked respondents to rate the overall effectiveness of the instruction and the instructor by marking Strongly Agree, Agree, Disagree, and Strongly Disagree. The survey also asked students to write their overall impression of the presentation as well as provide ideas for future library orientations.


