

## LIL' TIGERS BASKETBALL CAMP

The 17th annual Lil' Tigers Basketball Camp, will be held on June 17-21, 2019 from 9:00 am till 12:00 daily, for boys and girls grades  $1^{\circ}$  – 9th at CCC's Pinnacle.

The camp will be under the direction of Coahoma Community College Women's Basketball Retiree, Mississippi Community College Sports Hall of Famer and Clarksdale/Coahoma County 2014 Sports Hall of Famer, Coach Ella Morris, who brings thirty-three years of teaching and coaching experiences to the camp.

Tuition for the camp is only \$50.00 to help defray the cost of the camp. Each camper will receive tor-rate instruction on all fundamentals, Camp T-shirt, Certificate of Attendance Game skill evaluation and other competition awards which will be given on the last day of camp. The competitions included are Free Throw, 3-Point, and 3-On-3. 1st and 2nd places will receive Medals and 3nd place will receive Certificates.
