College enrollment has been declining since 2010





In the past decade, total college enrollment has dropped nearly 1.5 million

students (7.4%)





Undergraduate enrollment (6% of the 7.4%) during covid) 900k students



Financial concerns – Reason # 1

- ✓ 48% of High Schoolers will pursue a college degree
- ✓ 50% of High Schoolers think success is attainable without college
- √ 86% of High Schoolers are pressured to pursue a 4 year college degree




